PLANNING TO TRAVEL ABROAD? PLAN TO GET YOUR PASSPORT!

A **Passport Day** will be held on Saturday, February 6, 2015 from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. at the Dickinson County Treasurer's Office, Dickinson County Courthouse, located at 705 South Stephenson Avenue in Iron Mountain.

Applicants must bring with them proof of U.S. Citizenship, picture identification and a personal check or money order for the passport fees due to the Department of State. Both parents must accompany an applicant who is 15 years or younger. The \$25.00 execution fee may be paid with cash or check.

Representatives from the County Clerk's office will be on hand to make certified copies of birth certificates if the applicant was born in Dickinson County. Passport photo services are available on site for a \$15.00 fee.
