11. Controller's Report.

Controller Bousley stated we are working with the Michigan Works 8-week program for hiring for the parks and courthouse summer help.

The airport CARES ACT grant is submitted monthly and we are working on paying off the hangers. Camping at Lake Antoine will be open on the 22nd and we will be ready.

We have received the Veterans grant of \$50,000 and if we do spend it all we can get an additional \$16,000.

We received a \$15,000 grant for the upgrade of the electrical. We received \$500,000 Community Stability share, so we are only 1 million in the hole now. We received a RAP grant for the tasers.

Commissioner Pirlot asked about the sewer project at the Senior Center. Controller Bousley stated that is almost completed.

12. Citizen's Time (Limited to five minutes per person)

Chairman Wender opened the floor to Citizens' Time Dale Alessandrini addressed the Board.

He stated that he is glad they tabled the Senior Center negotiation. Everyone else is giving \$1500 to the Lake Antoine milfoil issue and it is not right that you are not contribution anything when it is your campground on that lake and without it the campground would be nothing.

13. Commissioners' Personal Privilege.

Commissioner Stevens stated he is happy that the hair salons are opening again and he thanked the Governor.

Commissioner Pirlot stated he supports our Sheriff Dept and credits the leader being an elected official. He also would like to curtail the late agenda items being added. He would like the Zoom

meetings to continue even where we start open meetings again.

Commissioner Kramer stated the Lake Antoine Park Partners will be discussing donating to the milfoil. They have 2 offers to replace the grate that was stolen by the spring. The dirt pile will be removed asap but it has been raining a lot. There have been lots of complaints about dogs running loose at the lake, the leash law starts at 9 am. Also, complaints about pontoon boats parking where they shouldn't be and she would like to see some enforcement.

Commissioner Degenauer stated in response to the milfoil issue, if we give to one lake we need to give to the other ones as well.

Commissioner Wender stated he was disappointed about the action taken on the Senior Center.
